Airport Arrivals

1. Visa requirements:

2. Travel guidelines for international saints:

- a. All the saints entering the Philippines must go online to complete the Electronic Travel Documents within 72 hours of travel.
- b. The Philippine government has recently issued new guidelines for the use of the Electronic Travel Declaration System instead of paper forms for all arrivals and departures. You can know more about the updated entry guidelines here: <https://etravel.gov.ph/entry-guidelines>.

3. Airport Information:

- a. The Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA, IATA code: MNL, ICAO code: RPLL) serves the Metropolitan Manila area and is the main gateway to travel in the Philippines. NAIA has four separate terminal buildings, with Terminal 1 and Terminal 3 serving international routes.

4. Arrival Guidelines:

- a. Airport pick-ups will only cover flights on July 23, 2024. Arrivals outside of this date will need to arrange their own transportation to the accommodation areas or venue.
- b. Upon arrival in Manila, you will pass through immigration counters and then proceed to the luggage carousel to collect your bags, after which there is a customs screening if you have any items to declare.

- d. Serving saints will be stationed at the Arrivals area (particularly the waiting area for non-passengers) in each terminal. Approach the saints who are holding up signs/banners for the ICTA for assistance.

5. Currency Exchange:

- a. We advise all the international saints to bring US Dollars for exchanging to Philippine Peso. Money changers may charge higher processing fees when you use your local currency, which will lessen the converted amount of your exchange.
